WHAT IS AN "ADVENTURE"?

If you **explore** it, **create** or **make** it, **experience** or **learn** about something, or even just **observe** or **participate**, it counts as an "Adventure".

Here are just a few examples:

enter the NSES summer photo contest - play an instrument - **work in the garden** - learn about a new place - **look for shells at the beach** - take a hike - **make up a game** - spend time outside - **take a boat ride** - go for a swim - **follow a recipe** - try a new food - **photograph nature** - explore a new trail - **go for a walk** - go fishing - **write in a journal or create your own story** - build something - **create a piece of art**- visit a museum - **attend a concert**- go camping **start a collection**
